

Reflection & Appeal

Today we are reminded of Jesus' concern for the sick and for those who are excluded by illness from taking a full part in society or the Church.

Jesus was not afraid to reach out and touch the leper, quite an amazing thing to do, because we so often step back from our brothers and sisters who have a disease or need assistance. Jesus shows us how to relate to such people who need our help, and to do it willingly.

In our archdiocese those who are sick or need assistance take pride of place at the heart of the annual pilgrimage of over 1300 people to Lourdes. This includes over 500 young people who willingly travel overland to help our assisted pilgrims. Without the support and generosity of service of you, the people in the archdiocese, our sick people would not be able to experience a pilgrimage. But in order to sustain our pilgrimage into the future we need you, the people in our parishes, to join us in giving of your time to serve those who are frail. In so doing we follow our Lord, reaching out to those for whom He has a special care. Making the pilgrimage is a personal sacrifice, but we gain more than we give....

Many of our faithful helpers have now had to step back from active participation as the years pass, and we urgently need more help. We need you and what you have to offer, to bring new life to all our teams (hospitality, music group, St. Bernadette Team, youth pilgrims)...

We are 'One Archdiocese' and this 'One Pilgrimage' in the year brings our family together. Please be generous.... and I pray that you will have the courage to respond

Ash Wednesday - Lent

Lent starts this Wednesday when ashes will be blessed and distributed at morning and evening mass, reminding us of our mortality. As we begin our forty days of preparing for Easter with this day of fasting and abstinence, we focus on greater charity through prayer, penance and repentance.

During the Sundays of Lent, starting next Sunday, there will be a *Holy Hour in front of the Blessed Sacrament at* **3:00pm**. We will use the resources for the Holy Hours in preparation for the Eucharistic Congress in September and for the Synod.

Traditionally the **Stations of the Cross** are prayed on the Wednesdays or/and Fridays of Lent. Volunteers willing to lead these when Father Graeme is not available would be very helpful, please see him ASAP. If people wish to follow the devotions privately, resources will be available in Church, but please do not remove them. The first communal celebration of the Stations of the Cross will be on Friday after the first Sunday in Lent, 23rd Feb., then on Wednesdays and Fridays.

On Ash Wednesday you may pick up a beautifully produced card 'Amoris Laetitia'/'The Joy of Love in preparation for the World Meeting of Families in Dublin. We will say this prayer daily at the end of Mass during Lent to strengthen spiritual life in our families.

All are most welcome, especially couples preparing for marriage and those who help them prepare the newly married and all who will be celebrating significant anniversaries in 2018.
