REFLECTION

Today's Gospel account of the Visitation provides us with a rare glimpse into the heart of Mary. Here we see the longest recorded account of Mary's own words in what is traditionally called the Magnificat. After experiencing the announcement from the Angel Gabriel that she will bear Jesus, Mary went guickly to her cousin, Elizabeth, where she was greeted with great joy. Filled with the Holy Spirit, she exclaimed, 'Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb' (words familiar to us all from the Hail, Mary). Elizabeth recognised the great privilege Mary had been given in being chosen to be the mother of the Messiah and the tremendous faith Mary must have had to say yes to God. But Mary did not respond by patting herself on the back - instead she turned immediately to praising and thanking God. The beautiful words in her Magnificat show us her beauty and humility. She was filled with joy that God would choose her for this

task and she praised God for the many gifts he had bestowed upon her. Mary's words evidence the purity of her soul and bring great promise that all the evils of the world are simply upside down pathways by which God will bring about great things - victory for the meek, bestow power on leaders who act as servants, bring the hungry at last to the table, and widely show mercy to all - God's grace in action makes the upside-down world right-side up again!

Mary was a faithful servant of God throughout her life, always able to say 'yes' to Him because of the grace poured out upon her. Her alignment with God's will (based on her

Immaculate Conception) is what allowed her to be assumed into heaven at the end of her earthly life. Unlike the ascension in which Jesus 'ascended' into heaven, an action done by Himself as God; Mary was 'assumed' into heaven, an action done by another other than herself. God assumed the one whom He chose to be the mother of Jesus. It is both because of Mary's place in God's plan, and her courageous and humble response, that we too are here to live our faith in Jesus Christ. Let us pray today that God's grace in us will do what it did for Mary.

COVID 19 - CHANGES FROM 19TH JULY

In the light of further guidance received from the Archdiocese, going forward, the following will apply at both St Gregory's & St Oswald's from **Monday 19th July 2021**

- The wearing of facemasks will be **mandatory** for those attending all church services (except in the case of medical exemption).
- Social distancing will no longer be mandatory but taking into consideration that some people may still have concerns given the current infection rates, a section of the church will remain with social distancing restrictions in place.
- Hand sanitising will remain a requirement on entering the church but not on exit.
- We will no longer be taking details for track and trace purposes.
- Holy Communion will revert to the normal time and place in the Mass.
- Holy Communion under both kinds will not be re-introduced at this time.
- Stewards will invite people to the altar to receive Holy Communion row by row.
