

Saint of the Week Madre Dio

Born in 1887 in the small Italian village of Pietrelcina, he joined the Capuchin Friars aged 16 and was ordained a priest seven years later. For 50 years at the monastery of San Giovanni Rotundo he was a much sought after spiritual advisor, confessor and intercessor whose life was devoted to the Eucharist and prayer. He became the first priest to receive the stigmata and in 1956 he founded a hospital which serves 60,000 a

year. Despite such notoriety, he often said, 'I only want to be a poor friar who prays'. His motto - Pray, hope and don't worry.
