St. Catherine of Siena

Catherine Benincasa was the youngest of twenty or more children of a Sienese dyer. She lived around 1333 – 1380, becoming a member of the Dominican Third Order. She devoted time to prayer and penance, and helping the sick in hospital. She later journeyed widely in a call to reform and repentance.

In the last five years of her life, she was involved in the politics of Church and State, working for the return of the papacy from Avignon to Rome. This makes her one of the leading figures of the fourteenth century.

Both a contemplative and ascetic, her writings are remarkable and well known for their spirituality and theology.
