
# Saints Joachim and Anne

By tradition Joachim and Anne are considered to be the names of the parents of Mary, the Mother of God. We have no historical evidence, however, of any elements of their lives, including their names. Any stories about Mary's father and mother come to us through legend and tradition, the oldest of them from the apocryphal gospel of James.

The legend told in this document says that after years of childlessness, an angel appeared to tell Anne and Joachim that they would have a child. Anne promised to dedicate this child to God, much the way that Samuel was dedicated by his mother Hannah, Anne (see the Book of Kings).

Whatever the facts of their lives, the Church honours the parents of Mary because they nurtured her, taught her and brought her up to be a devout Jewish woman and a worthy Mother of God. It was their teaching that led her to respond to God with Faith 'Let it be done to me as you will.'

It was their example of parenting that Mary must have followed in bringing up Jesus, and their example of faith which made her grow in courage and strength, even unto standing by the cross as her son was crucified, - and she still believed.

'Laudato Si', the Pope's encyclical on protecting the natural world and combating poverty, is taking centre stage at the Justice and Peace annual conference from 21 – 23 July. Francis has presented us with a challenge to live with love and joy in this our common home.
