## Saint of the week


## Saint John Vianney

Born in 1786, the son of a farmer, John became a shepherd with little schooling. Aged 20 he began his studies for the priesthood. Finding studies, especially Latin, difficult, he was still admitted to orders as the most devout, if also the most unlearned of the students.

Becoming parish priest (1817) of Ars-en-Dombe, a remote and unimportant village of about 250 inhabitants, he spent the rest of his life there, living mainly on potatoes.

He excelled in preaching and counselling. His insight into personal difficulties seemed to have been helped by supernatural gifts of reading the secrets of hearts.

Every day, St. John preached at 11:00am. Just before his death, when visitors were reputedly numbering 20.000 a year, he sometimes spent 16 hours a day celebrating the sacrament of confession. He is patron of all the priests of the world.
