




Saint of the Week

ST. AMBROSE

Born in Trier about 339 he became governor of Aemilia and Liguria and, mediating between the Catholics and Arians, was asked to become bishop by popular demand. He was baptised on 24th Nov. 373 and ordained priest and consecrated bishop on December 1st, holding the See of Milan till his death in 397. More than any other man he handed on to the middle ages the legacy of Rome: objective justice and law, responsibility of office, integrity and unbroken dignity. He is well known for introducing the much loved eastern custom of singing hymns into the western Church.

His greatest convert, St. Augustine, asked him for baptism in 387, seeing in St. Ambrose a great Man of God and devoted pastor of His flock.

Action for Catholic Education - Request from the Archbishop

Do you support Catholic schools and the right of Catholics to send their children to them? Then we need you to make your voice heard. The Government is making a critical decision on whether to overturn the admissions cap which prevents new Catholic schools from allowing all Catholic pupils to attend. The Prime Minister has acknowledged that this policy discriminates against Catholics and had promised previously to abandon it. Now the Government may decide to keep this discriminatory policy in place instead of removing it. We need you to tell the Government not to discriminate against Catholics and to remove the admissions cap on new faith-based schools.
