REFLECTING ON TODAY'S GOSPEL

We often ask ourselves what is most important in our lives. Various words come to mind – family, faith, love, peace of mind, money amongst others. Jesus is asked something like this in the conversation of today's gospel. His most important word is love – anything in the religious tradition of the time is secondary to the love of God and love of the neighbour. Maybe we could challenge that we are most religious, not necessarily when we are in church or praying, but whenever we are at our most loving and caring, or when we are showing concern for others. That's what true religion is, and it is especially true when it relates to caring for the needy. Jesus' heart went out to those who were needy in his own time, especially any group who were outcast, for example, those suffering from leprosy. The same can be said today. Jesus is the one on the side of the needy and most on our side when we are most needy. This is the meaning of a Christian community - to be bearers of love in our world. When we love, in the smallest and biggest ways, among family, neighbours, friends and the wider community, then we are religious in Jesus' name.

St Charles Borromeo: born in 1538; after obtaining a doctorate in civil and canon law he was created a cardinal by his uncle, Pope Pius IV, and was chosen to be Bishop of Milan. He became a true shepherd of his flock, and frequently visited his diocese, called synods, made wise regulations for the good of souls, and worked for the good of Christian morality.
