Our Lady of Fatima

On 13th May 1917 our 'Lady of the Rosary' appeared to three shepherd children in Fatima/Portugal, and then on the 13th of the five following months. Francisco and Jacinta, who died very young, were beatified by Pope St. John Paul II in 2000, and will be canonised by Pope Francis when he visits Fatima this Saturday to lead the centenary celebrations. Cardinal Vincent Nichols lead the service of re-consecration of England to the Immaculate Heart of Mary in April.

Thoughts on Vocations Sunday

The Church can be compared to a tree with branches and flowers – different callings and vocations making up the family of the Church.

Today we celebrate the priesthood and consecrated life.

If somebody calls me, I need to pick up the phone to get the message. A call needs action on part of the one who is called.

We are quite good at calling on God when we are in need of help, but do we listen out for his calling us? And do we respond?

'Speak Lord, your servant is listening', said the young Samuel in the story in the Bible, after consulting one of the elders and realising it was God who was calling his name every night.

A nice model of prayer if you are seeking to know God's will.

We need to be people who **listen** to God, respond with **love**, and then **live** accordingly day to day.

Such a vibrant church community enables others to hear God's call.

Perhaps YOU or somebody you know are called to the priesthood or consecrated life?

Open your heart to God and believe that God calls ordinary people to become priests or religious – no need to be heroic or completely at ease with the idea.

A discussion with a priest or religious about your own possible vocation can bring great joy.

To feel called by God to follow him in an exclusive way, to become a 24/7 disciple available for the needs of the family of the Church, requires something extra in an otherwise ordinary life.

Priests and Religious are not extraordinary, they are ordinary people called to make visible the extra dimensions in ordinary life.
