Saint of the Week St. John The Baptist

His name was divinely given. It was to be "John" (see Luke 1:13), which derives from a Hebrew term signifying "God is gracious". He was known familiarly as "the Baptist" which simply means "an immerser, one who administers the rite of immersion". (see Matthew 3:1, 11:11, etc) The Jewish historian Josephus even refers to John by this designation (Antiquities 18.5.2). The importance of John in the divine scheme of things probably is summed up best in the testimony of Jesus himself.

"Among them that are born of women there has not arisen a greater than John the Baptist.."
